EFFECTIVE as of JUNE 1, 2020:

The Department of Health, Tuberculosis (TB) Control Branch has restarted issuance of TB Clearances - Post COVID-19 quarantine (see revised operational updates below):

- Annual clearance for healthcare workers
- Annual clearance for patients in long-term care facilities
- Children entering childcare, preschool or school (K-12th grade) and children/school employees
- Post-secondary school students and employees
- Food handlers

The Lanakila Health Center TB Clinic (1700 Lanakila Ave., Honolulu) still accepts walkins with new procedures to monitor for COVID-19 and maintain social distancing. Individuals seeking TB clearance will need to wear a face covering and be health screened prior to entering clinic.

**NOTE:** Tuesdays and Thursdays from 1:00-2:30 pm, priority for testing will be given to accommodate Kupuna's (Senior citizens) and healthcare workers before other clearance categories:

**NEW:** To encourage social distancing, the TB program has developed an electronic process to request your TB clearance Statewide. Send in your TB request using the e-mail address provided doh.tbclearance@doh.hawaii.gov, include the following information in your message:

- Your Name(s) (first name, last name, (aka, your maiden name) of individuals seeking TB clearance
- Indicate relationship: (for example, self, children (0-17 years of age), senior parent due to long-term care placement).
- Primary phone number: (needs to be a number we can reach you during the day)
- Date of Birth
- Reason TB clearance is needed

A response will be made within one business day either by phone or by e-mail. Upon telephone interview with you, determination will be made whether we are able to process your TB clearance electronically or you will need to be seen in office.

# NOTE: There has been operational changes to Public Health Nursing Offices Statewide for TB Testing procedures due COVID-19 (see below).

The **Public Health Nursing (PHN) Offices** Statewide, who have been offering TB Testing clinics, will no longer conduct walk-in clinics. Any individual seeking TB clearance at these sites will now be required to call for an appointment for a TB skin test. However, some individuals may be able to receive clearance over the phone.

Calls can be made during **business hours**: 7:45am-4:30pm, Monday-Friday, except for holidays.
