Note from bylaws:\*\*When electing members the Legislature requires that consideration be given to persons who provide the governing board with a diversity of perspective and a level of objectivity that accurately represent the interest of the charter school students and the surrounding community; demonstrate an understanding of best practices of nonprofit governance; and possess strong financial and academic management and oversight abilities, as well as human resources and fundraising experience.

Have school vote during work day.

Governance committee to review the 33% rule prior to governing board meeting so that we are in compliance.

Accept the winning nominations on the May Board meeting.
