Taking into account the school's strategic plan and the 2015-2016 School Academic Plan, the following Academic Goals for the current school year are proposed:

Relative Performance Goals

- 1. Elementary (K-5) Math & Language Arts Scores, as measured by the Smarter Balanced Assessment, will be in the top 50% of all public schools.
- 2. Secondary (6-12) Math & Language Arts Scores, as measured by the HSA, will collectively be in the top 50% of all public schools.

Absolute Performance Goals

- 1. Elementary will show a 10% increase in the number of students meeting proficiency in both Math and Language Arts from the end of SY 14-15 to SY 15-16, as measured by the NWEA Measure of Academic Progress.
- 2. Secondary will show a 10% increase in the number of students meeting proficiency in both Math and Language Arts from the end of SY 14-15 to SY 15-16, as measured by the NWEA Measure of Academic Progress.

Student Gains

1. Every student continuously enrolled at LCPCS will achieve at least one year of growth in both Math and Language Arts as measured by either the Smarter Balanced Assessment or the NWEA Measure of Academic Progress.

Behavior Gains

1. Elementary and Secondary will realize a 30% reduction in total disciplinary referrals from the start of the school year to the end of the school year.

Mission Specific Outcomes

- 1. Every Elementary student will have a portfolio of student work that moves with them at the end of the year.
- 2. Every 6-11th grade student will have the beginnings of a Personal Success Plan that includes a portfolio of their work at the end of the year.
- 3. Every Senior will graduate with a Personal Transition and Success Plan which they embrace as a blueprint for their post high school plans.
- 4. 100% of our Seniors will graduate and enter college, the workforce, or the military within 6 months of graduation.
